There will be several events throughout the week offering more information for families.

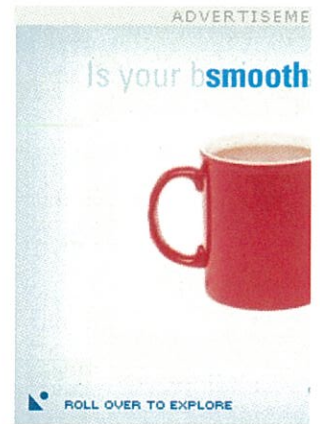
